

PARISH NEWS

- Deacon Martyn Chambers has been appointed as Parish Administrator and I am delighted that he has taken up this role. He will be instrumental in the governance of the parish. He is now the Chair of the PPC.
- The Parish Council formally reconvenes and is meeting on the 23rd September to discuss the building project and relations with our other communities. If there are items you wish at some stage to be discussed and/or brought to the notice of the PPC – please see Deacon Martyn.
- We have now reached the stage in the development of the parish infrastructure and church where the project stages and costs need to be approved. The rough timetable is issuing of tenders at the end of September, the receipt of tenders and approval by the diocese in November. Potential start of the work mid-January 2026 lasting about 5 months.
- The Syro-Malabar have decided that understandably they need a weekly Sunday liturgy and so are now using Centenary Church, hence the drop in numbers. With the Polish moving to Saint Christopher's, this gives us time to regroup as a parish and it has become clearer now who makes up the stable parish congregation.
