Following on from the announcement at Mass this past weekend, we are pleased to share that Bishop Patrick has invited our parish to take part in the Enabling Our Mission campaign over the coming months.

This fundraising endeavour aims to make our Diocese and its parishes more outward-looking and missionary-focussed. The three key priorities are:

- Equipping our priests and lay leaders with the tools and resources they need to lead a move to mission
- Alleviating the ever-growing administrative workload of clergy
- Responding effectively to the local requirements of parishes and helping laity grow in their faith

To enable this work, we are currently undertaking a census during our weekend Masses to ensure that we have up-to-date contact details for those in our parish. As this initiative progresses, we will keep you informed and provide further updates in due course.

For now, please pray for the success of the Enabling Our Mission campaign.

NEXT STAGE: Once the census has been completed people will be invited to meetings either as couples, individuals or in a group to discuss the campaign and to see if they can pledge some money for the campaign.
